Aprons for artists and volunteers</li> <li>2. 2 Dining trays for sharing artwork (for floating the mat on top of the tray)</li> <li>3. Lap desks or clip boards for people in wheelchairs that cannot get close enough to the table</li> <li>4. Hanger to clip multiple wet art pieces</li> <li>5. Table cloths</li> </ol>
